

Dear Potential PT Resident:

We wanted to make you aware of some construction going on near Promontory Tower (PT). This summer the construction of the Hurst Lifelong Learning Center has begun. The construction site is located in the west parking lot of Promontory Tower. Like any construction site it is somewhat noisy and right now, at least, fairly dusty. The construction is scheduled for completion in April 2009.

Access to the building will be from the east parking lot only, either through the basement with an elevator or up the stairs to the main level. Parking will be available along the street as well as other lots across the street.

The Hurst Center will not be an extremely tall building, and the lowest resident floor in PT begins on the sixth floor, giving some separation from the noise. However, it may still get noisy at times. We wanted to make you aware of this before you arrived this fall.

Because of the constrained parking situation and the potential noise that the construction will create, we will credit you half the cost of an RW parking pass. You will purchase your parking pass separate from your housing costs through Parking Services, and you will need to pay full price for it (\$58) up front. After move-ins and after we have verified you are living in PT, we will credit you half of the cost (\$29).

We look forward to seeing you this fall and hope this information helps as you prepare to arrive.
